In 1943, Green Lake's founders established the conference center for the purpose of "nurturing and training leaders for the cause of Christianity and the World Mission of the Church," even as the world was in crisis in the middle of the Second World War. The end of the war was uncertain, as this preceded the D-Day invasion in Normandy and Pacific islands invasions. And yet, this group acted, inspired by the conviction that the world needed Christian leaders. In my speech on the 9th of August, 2019,* I noted that one title for the story of the first 75 years of GLCC might be "improbable endurance" as there have been so many threats to our survival that one cannot explain in human terms alone how the conference center has survived. But for the past 75 years:

Summer and winter and springtime and harvest, sun, moon, and stars in their courses above join with all nature in manifold witness to thy great faithfulness, mercy, and love.

We began 2020 engaging exciting initiatives for God to launch the next 75 years of nurturing and training Christian leaders and we remain as passionate and committed as ever to this mission. However, a surprise wave is washing over us in the form of a coronavirus.

Great is thy faithfulness, O God our Father! Morning by morning new mercies I see: all we need we seek thy hand to provide--Great is thy faithfulness, Lord, unto me!

We ask you to pray for Green Lake and our staff as we seek God's provision, confident in God's great faithfulness in the past, today and for the future. We also ask you to consider making a special financial donation for this unique short term cash flow challenge -- unprecedented in our 75 year history. With confidence shaken and tensions arisen, the world needs Christian leaders to share the resurrection news, the pathway through Christ alone to Heaven, and the hope of God's love.


