Founders Victor & Jessie Lawson developed our estate in the late 1800s and early 1900s as a farm. Much of their European-inspired architecture remains present today. The farm was developed into a luxurious country club in the 1920s, and in 1943 the American Baptists purchased the estate for training conferences. Since

Meeting Spaces

Make yourself comfortable in 60,000 square feet spread across 50 rooms. Our two largest meeting rooms feature views of the lake and measure 7,800 sq ft each.
