Interesting History

Founders Victor & Jessie Lawson developed our estate in the late 1800s and early 1900s as a farm. Much



of their Europeaninspired architecture remains present today.

The farm was developed into a luxurious country club in the 1920s, and in late 1943 the American Baptists purchased the estate

for inspiration and national training. In June of 1944, youth were the first to convene at the newly established conference center.
