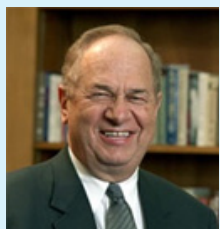

★ An Informed Global View

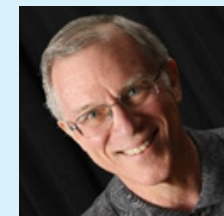
